



Title: Going on a photography scavenger hunt

Objectives:

- To develop imagination, attention, different understanding of environmental details;
- To get acquainted with the art of photography and the profession of a photographer.

Equipment: mobile phone, camera, tablet, self-made cameras, stencil, cardboard, plain white sheet of paper, scissors, drawing kit.

Stage 1: The children discuss with the teacher what photography actually is and get acquainted with the profession of a photographer.

Stage 2: Choose with what the photographs will be taken (mobile phone, camera, tablet, self-made camera).

Stage 3: If you choose to take photos with a self-made camera, you can make it (description Appendix No.1).

Stage 4: The task for children is to take photos of selected objects in the territory.

Stage 5: Create a collage from the photos and hold an exhibition in the classroom.

Appendix No.1

Option 1. On cardboard the children draw a camera according to an example given by the teacher and then cut it out. Cut a strip of white paper according to the size of the camera window. The strip is divided into frames (the child decides how many frames there will be). Then attaches the tape to the camera. The children draw on each part of the tape what they have "photographed".



Option 2: On cardboard the children draw a camera according to an example given by the teacher and then cut it out. Simulate the photography outside.
