



Title: Making toys from secondary raw materials

Objectives:

- Develop artistic skills and creativity;
- Encourage co-operation between children, parents and teachers;
- Develop skills of nature protection;
- Encourage usage of secondary raw materials.

Tools: various secondary raw materials, glue, threads, wire, paint, colouring tools, scissors, table, chairs.

Stage 1: Accumulation of clean secondary raw materials at educational institution and home.

Stage 2: Toys are made from secondary raw materials in educational institution or outside, if weather is good.

Stage 3: Prepare working area and required tools before starting creative process: secondary raw materials (place them in single area), tools to strengthen materials, scissors and colouring tools.

Stage 4: Teacher shows few samples of already made toys from secondary raw materials, so it would be easier to imagine final look of the toy for children. Children start to imagine what toy they will be making, it can be anything: a car, human, animal, plant, etc. Once children knows what toy they will be making, they start to fulfil the idea by making toy of secondary raw materials. Teacher advices how to strengthen raw materials together, helps if needed. Children selects tools to decorate with once the toy is made.

Stage 5: Organize an exhibition of toys made from secondary raw materials (it is recommended to do exhibition outside).
