



Title: Spray paint activity

Objectives:

- Get acquainted with the art technique-spraying paint;
- To develop imagination, creativity;
- To develop aesthetic perception.

Equipment: Gouache, acrylic, colored chalk, water, sprayers, thicker paper for stencils, various items, paper or fabric, food wrap film, wet wipes for cleaning hands.

Stage 1: This activity is carried outdoors.

Stage 2: The teacher discusses the workflow with the pupils and prepares the workplace outdoors. Stretches the food wrap films between some prepared sticks that are in the ground or just between some trees. Fabric or paper for spilled paint is applied under the food wrap films.

Stage 3: The children prepare the paint - water is added inside the sprayers and gouache of the desired color is added, then one needs to shake it well.

Stage 4: Multicolored paint is sprayed on the stretched food wrap film with the sprayers.

Other options:

1. Drawing on white fabric

The stretched fabric is being sprayed with paint. The colors blend with each other. Children explore colors and enjoy creative freedom.

2. Drawing with colored chalk

The colored chalk is crushed and poured into sprayers. Then water is added and everything shaken up for the chalk to dissolve.

Stencils are made of thicker paper. They are placed on the pavement outside and sprayed with paint. Removing the stencils results in the desired colorful drawings. This can be repeated several times in different places, with different colors.

3. A drawing from things.

Various items are collected, for example, leaves, metal keys, forks, threads and other. They are glued to a sheet of paper or fabric creating an image, for example, a face, car, flower. Then the prepared paint, preferably acrylic, is sprayed in one color. This is how a bas-relief drawing is obtained.

4. Multilayer coatings.

On a white piece of paper put a selected item or a cut out of thicker paper silhouette. Then spray paint spray. After that the silhouette or object is moved and sprayed again in another color. This is how to learn perspectives and discover new colors.

Advice: This creative process is a bit messy. Dress properly.
