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TITLE: Spraying graffiti on the driveway while GOING HIKING WITH CHILDREN

OBJECTIVES:

- to be healthy
- to observe nature
- to recognize trees
- to gain observation skills

MATERIALS: Spray paint, lens, paper, pencil

STAGE 1: The play need to be played outside

STAGE 2: The teacher determines the playing area and with how many students the play will be played

STAGE 3: The students are taken to the garden

STAGE 4: The teacher determines the route and stop points to be observed with spray paint

STAGE 5: When the game starts, the child examines the trees, flowers, insects and animals on the route.

STAGE 6: At the first stop he/she examines a tree, its leaves, trunk, branches and continues on the same route when the examination is finished.

STAGE 7: At the second stop, she uses her lens to examine the soil and the creatures living in it.

STAGE 8: At the third stop, she examines the flower, the leaf, stem and root of the flower with her lens.

STAGE 9: At the end of the route, she shares with her friends how the nature walk makes her feel mentally and physically.

STAGE 10: Draws the route and stopping points of the nature walk.
