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Title: Outdoor game: The Danube Delta Biosphere Reservation

Objectives:

- getting to know the values of nature;
- promoting the outdoor activities;
- developing social skills.

Equipment: pens, sheets of paper, sheets of paper with tasks prepared earlier by the teacher.

Stage 1: It's highly recommended to play the game in the park or a forest known by some historical events and nature aspects.

Stage 2: The outdoor game takes place in the forest on the bank of the Danube.

Stage 3: The tasks of the game were prepared in advance by the teacher, but also how the students will be seated during the game. The questions concern, the year of the declaration of the area as a reserve, the unique plants and animals that are in this area. Example of prepared questions for students.

-In what year the area was declared as a reserve?

-Name several tree species in this area.

-What is the name of the river on whose bank is located the forest in which we are located?

-What animals and birds live in the reserve?

-What activities can we carry out in the reserve and what activities are we not allowed to carry out?

Stage 4: The teacher explains the rules of the game to the students, and then the students divide into teams. Each team takes sheets of paper and pens. They are divided into teams and each team chooses a leader of the group. Teams start answering questions at the same time.

Stage 5: The teacher checks the students` responses and announces the winning team that will be rewarded.
