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## Title: The animals hunt

### Objectives:

- stimulating students' imagination;
- enhancing students' knowledge of the nature and animals;
- learning an interesting new game.

**Materials, equipment:** for two students – a plastic box, potting soil, animal puzzles, for each student – rubber gloves,, a small plastic box, a pen and worksheet.

**Stage 1:** It's better to play the game outdoors, however depending on the weather conditions it can also be played inside the school.

**Stage 2:** The teacher prepares the right place for carrying out the activity, namely at the playground. The teacher prepares the necessary materials for each group of students, as well as for each student. For each group, a working table containing a plastic box with potting soil is prepared and for each student are prepared the following materials, rubber gloves, small plastic boxes, sheets of paper and pens.

**Stage 3:** The teacher explains what the work to be carried out consists of, in the plastic boxes they will find puzzle pieces from which they will make various wild animals and will have to write the name of the animal, respectively on a sheet of paper. Each group of students will have to give some information about the animal made from the puzzle, and the colleagues will intervene and add new things.

**Stage 4:** Students work in pairs, look for the puzzle parts at and then arrange them so that they get a wild animal. In front of the colleagues they will mention the respective animal and give some information about it. The other students intervene when they want to add new information, and during the activity the students will be guided and encouraged by the teacher.
