

Title: Playing with a sprinkler

Objectives:

- ingiting the imagination;
- observing the process of evaporation;
- enhancing motor condition.

Equipment: a sprinkler/ water hose, a wall

Stage 1: It's highly recommended that the activity would take place during a warm/hot day.

Stage 2: The teacher chooses the right place around the school, somewhere near a tall wall.

Stage 3: The teacher divides children in small groups (of 5 or six), and explains the rules: children stand next to the wall (they should touch it), and look at it. They make some funny figures (using their hands, legs, heads, hair, etc.), and don't move.

Stage 4: The teacher using the sprinkler and water tries to outline the figure made by children. When the teacher finishes, children may see the figure made of water on the wall.

Stage 5: The observation won't take long, because the water evaporates very quickly.

Stage 6: Now, the next group may start the game.

Stage 7: It's highly recommended that the game should be played under the supervision of a teacher or an adult.

Now, it's just to take the sprinkler and... play!
