

All arrangements after the online meeting in December 2020:

1. Partners will meet online on 27th January - from each country 5 students (aged 6-8), students do the quiz prepared by Polish partner in English (partner will send the quiz a few days before the meeting, so that the teachers could translate them to their mother tongue), the quiz will be in English.
2. Before the meeting, teachers will teach the students about:  
capital cities, countries location (on a map), the biggest rivers, whether the countries have sea/ocean/ mountains and what are their names (the biggest ones), currency.
3. Partners will take some pictures of the lessons, in which you teach this information, and post it on social media.
4. From 11th till 18th January students will write the weather and the temperature in each country, then partners will share the observations and show them to students - teachers will talk to students about the differences.
5. From 8th till 22nd February children plant some beans, broccoli or any other, and they take photos of their plants, teachers post the photos on FB, eTwinning, etc.
